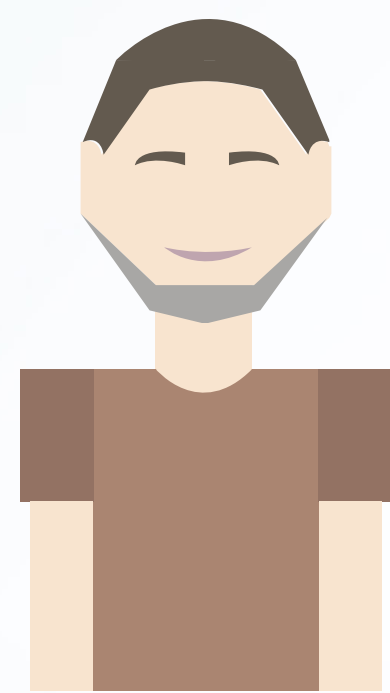
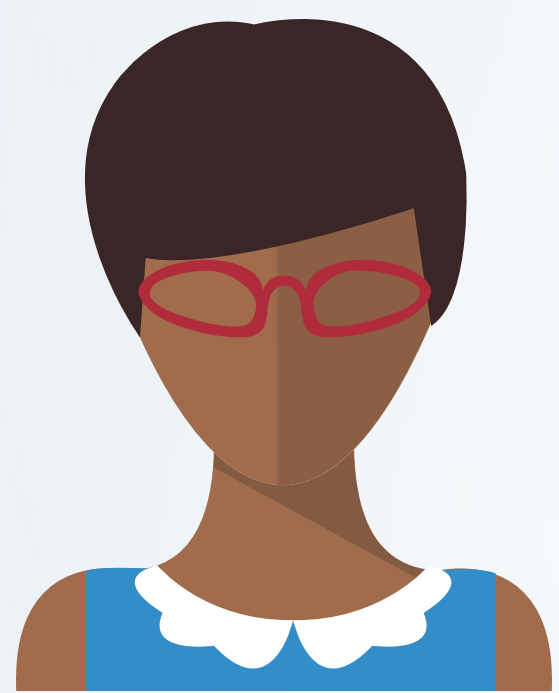


# Listening to the Views and Aspirations of Older People in relation to Housing

We would like to invite you to take part in an **individual conversation** or **telephone call** to discuss topics covering your views about :

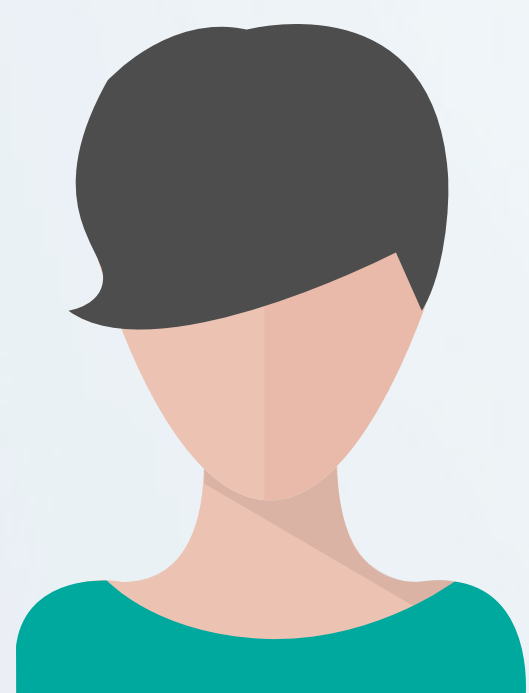


If you were considering a move, what factors would matter to you most?
